This is a transitional quarterly report for the CARES Regional HMIS. It was developed to assist communities prepare for the upcoming changes in data standards while also incorporating newly requested data elements into the report. The current report has been broken into two sections: **Housing** and **Supportive Services Only**. Both sections contain breakdowns by HUD project type. Unlike past years, these reports will no longer be a cumulative spreadsheet; the amount of information and the way it now needs to be broken down no longer support that format.

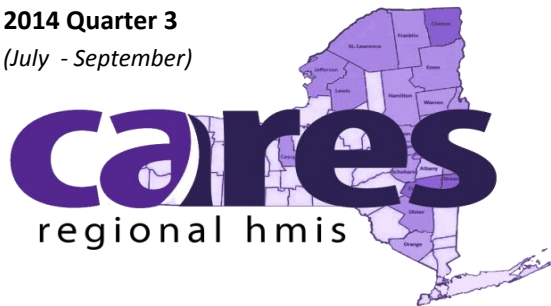
Both the Housing and Supportive Services reports were modeled after the current AHAR format to help align with HUD standards and provide a better basis for community planning and comparison with the published AHAR both at the local and Federal level.
