QUARTERLY HMIS REPORT

(Q2 of Federal Fiscal Year 2015)

This is the quarterly report for the CARES Regional Homeless Management Information System (CRHMIS). The CRHMIS reports follow the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) of October 1st through September 30th rather than the calendar year. New HMIS data standards went into effect 10/1/14 and are reflected in FFY 2015 reporting.

The HMIS is a community-run, federally mandated database which collects data on the characteristics of homeless and at risk persons in a community in order to inform services and system planning efforts. This data is also reported, in unduplicated, de-identified, aggregate form to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to inform policy and regulations and make recommendations to Congress for spending.

The report is broken into two sections: **Housing** and **Supportive Services Only**. Different project types have different reporting criteria and projects not funded through the Continuum of Care (CoC) may not collect more than the Universal Data Elements (UDEs), found in the 2014 Data Standards available under the User Resources tab of our website: <http://www.caresny.org> or via email (below).

Reporting is modeled after the current Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR) to help align with HUD standards and provide a better basis for community planning and comparison with the published AHAR both at the local and Federal level.

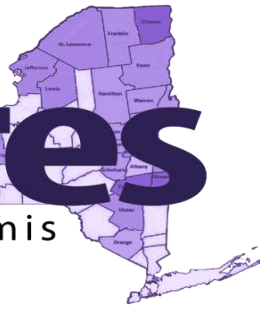

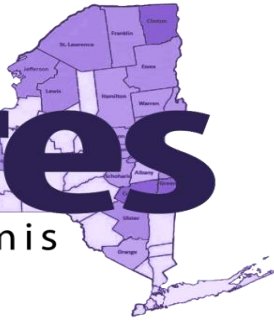
