The Points North Housing Coalition serves the counties of Jefferson, Lewis and St. Lawrence. The purpose of the Points North Housing Coalition is to provide supportive community structure with agencies and individuals concerned with meeting the needs of the homeless and/or those at risk of homelessness within the tri-county. Points North Housing Coalition, a HUD approved Continuum of Care provides participating member agencies avenues for improving housing access including submission of HUD, OTDA, and Department of Veterans Affairs grant applications. The Coalition informs regional and local jurisdictions of needs assessments in order to participate in housing planning.

Exactly what is a Continuum of Care?

It is a comprehensive community plan to organize and deliver housing and human services to individuals who are homeless as they move through the rehabilitation process. The final goal is to prevent a return to homelessness and to help create the greatest achievable level of self-sufficiency for our consumers.

What are the benefits of joining Points North?
