

## NEW PROJECTS

### **CAPTAIN Community Human Services**

#### **CAPTAIN CHS Coordinated Entry (2021)**

**Project Description:** CAPTAIN CHS is requesting new funding to create a CE Coordinator position. This position will manage and administrate the CoC's CE system, oversee client services from program intake to program exit, monitor and facilitate data entry in the CoC's HMIS system, facilitate case conferencing, and manage the Coordinated Entry waitlist. Having a funded CE Coordinator will allow the SNCCoC to successfully meet the current and future HUD requirements for CE System in a planful, coordinated, and robust manner.

### **Saratoga County Rural Preservation Company**

#### **SVAP Expansion (2021)**

**Project Description:** VCHC is requesting an expansion of funding for the Saratoga Veterans Apartment Program. Homeless, disabled veterans with little to no income at the target population for this program. The program will adhere to the Housing First Model, accepting Veterans regardless of income status, active or past due substance abuse, criminal background or history of domestic violence.

### **CARES of NY, Inc.**

#### **SNC CoC Planning Project**

**Project Description:** Corporation for AIDS Research, Education and Services, Inc. (CARES) requests funds to support the operations of the CoC. Proposed funds will support coordination and facilitation of the CoC's processes, including strengthening the current CoC system, assisting with the development and implementation of a coordinated assessment system, conducting project evaluation and monitoring, conducting annual Housing Inventory and Point-in-Time Count, participating in the Consolidated Plan, and preparing and submitting the CoC's application to HUD.

#### **Warren, Washington, Hamilton, and Saratoga Counties HMIS Expansion**

**Project Description:** Corporation for AIDS Research, Education and Services, Inc. (CARES) requests funds to support the addition of community-level data analysis with modeling and predictive analytics to the CoC's existing data management structure. This will assist the CoC in understanding their populations, monitoring the impact of new and current initiatives, use data more inclusively, model the impact of new projects prior to their implementation, understand gaps in services, and adopt a data-driven approach to service delivery and gaps analysis.

## **WAIT House**

### **WAIT House Youth RRH**

**Program Description:** WAIT House is requesting new funding to support a new Rapid Rehousing program that will provide case management and rental assistance to pregnant and parenting youth. This program will primarily serve those discharging from the WAIT House TLP program but will also work with our CoC's Coordinated Entry System to assist other pregnant and parenting youth in need of RRH services. It is anticipated that this funding will support between 2 and 4 households per year with rental assistance.

## **Catholic Charities of Saratoga, Warren, and Washington Counties**

### **DVPWW Housing 2021**

**Program Description:** Catholic Charities of Saratoga, Warren, and Washington Counties is requesting funding to support the creation of a Rapid Rehousing program to assist homeless domestic violence survivors secure and maintain stable permanent housing. The DVP will assign a staff person to serve as a Housing Advocate dedicated to working with homeless program participants and accessing resources and collaboration with community housing partners including landlords and housing authorities. The Housing Advocate will assist at least 50 program participants in a 12-18 month period to locate, secure, and maintain safe, stable, and permanent housing. Up to 50 program participants will be assisted with funds to move quickly from homelessness into safe stable housing. Program participants will be assisted with varying amounts of funds based on the range of rental costs within the two counties. Program participants will be provided advocacy and support as requested to establish and maintain permanent housing.

## **RENEWAL PROJECTS**

### **Domestic Violence and Rape Crisis Services of Saratoga County dba Wellspring**

#### **NewView - Rapid Rehousing I**

Grant PIN: NY0187

**Project Description:** Wellspring requests continued funding to support an RRH program in Saratoga County. This project provides housing and supportive services to individuals and families who are homeless due to domestic violence and who have a disability of mental illness, chemical dependency, or HIV/AIDS and are actively engaged in treatment. The project assists twelve households (in four one-bedroom, four three-bedroom, and four two-bedroom units) in scattered site apartments, to attain and maintain stable housing and to increase self-sufficiency so they may exit the program to violence-free, sustainable living.

### **NewView Rapid Rehousing II**

**Grant Pin:** NY1221

**Project Description:** The proposed project will be a Rapid Rehousing project, with maximum 24-month subsidy. All Wellspring's services and programs are survivor centered, trauma informed and voluntary with a housing first orientation.

### **DV Coordinated Entry**

**Grant Pin:** NY1220

**Project Description:** The proposed project will be a Rapid Rehousing project, with maximum 24-month subsidy. All Wellspring's services and programs are survivor centered, trauma informed and voluntary with a housing first orientation. This project will specifically provide for 6 units to house a minimum of 8 domestic violence survivors.

### **NewView – Permanent Supportive**

Grant PIN: NY0184

**Project Description:** Wellspring requests continued funding to support a PSH program in Saratoga County. This project provides housing and supportive services to individuals and families who are homeless due to domestic violence and who have a disability of mental illness, chemical dependency, or HIV/AIDS and are actively engaged in treatment.

## **Saratoga County Rural Preservation Company**

### **Center Street Renewal**

Grant PIN: NY0188

**Project Description:** Saratoga County Rural Preservation Company requests continued funding to support a PSH program in Saratoga County. This project is designed to house homeless, disabled veterans and their families in permanent housing for a period of time leading to their ability to purchase a home of their own through an established savings program. The families are housed in a two-family home located in Ballston Spa, NY.

### **SVAP Renewal**

Grant PIN: NY1038

**Project Description:** Saratoga County Rural Preservation Company requests continued funding to support a PSH program in Saratoga County. This project supports twenty one units of permanent supportive housing including four studio apartments, fourteen one-bedroom apartments, and three two-bedroom apartments. All fourteen units of permanent housing are dedicated to chronically homeless veterans with little or no income. The program adheres to the Housing First Model.

### **CARES of NY, Inc.**

#### **Warren, Washington, Hamilton, and Saratoga Counties Portion of the Capital Region HMIS**

Grant PIN: NY0189

**Project Description:** Corporation for AIDS Research, Education and Services, Inc. (CARES) requests continued funding to support a HMIS program for CoC NY-523. This is a data collection program which holds client level data. Participation in the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) is a requirement for all recipients of CoC and Emergency Solutions Grant funds.

### **Adirondack Vets House, Inc.**

#### **AVH – Vets House**

Grant PIN: NY1218

**Project Description:** Adirondack Vet House requests continued funding to support a permanent housing program in Northern Saratoga, Warren and Washington Counties (please note: this project is transitioning from a transitional housing project to a permanent housing project). This project is a nine-bed co-ed permanent housing program for homeless veterans with disabilities located in Glens Falls, NY. The program assists veterans in all areas of their lives in order to help them make a transition into permanent housing while reducing or eliminating the barriers that have created homelessness.

### **RISE Housing and Support Services**

#### **TSA - Housing First**

Grant PIN: NY1163

**Project Description:** The Transitional Services Association, Inc. (TSA) requests funds to support a permanent housing program to provide tenant-based rental assistance to 32 homeless households with disabilities in Saratoga County. These disabilities include mental illness, chronic substance abuse problems, and/or HIV/AIDS. In addition to receiving rental assistance, RAP participants are assisted in accessing supportive services within the community. The proposed project will operate under the Housing First Model.

### **WAIT House**

#### **WAIT House – TLP Renewal Project**

Grant PIN: NY0673

**Project Description:** WAIT House requests continued funding to support a TH program in Saratoga, Warren and Washington Counties. This Transitional Living Program (TLP) project for Homeless Pregnant and Parenting Youth serves homeless youth ages sixteen to 21. The TLP is certified by the NYS Office of Children and Family Services to house up to five mothers and five infants for up to twelve months. The project provides case management, supportive services, and

linkages to services to assist the residents in attaining a stable independent living situation in permanent housing and to be able to make healthy choices for themselves and their child. The project is located in Glens Falls, NY and serves youth from Warren, Washington and Saratoga Counties.

### **Warren Washington Association for Mental Health**

#### **MHA Warren Washington – Housing First**

Grant PIN: NY0716

**Project Description:** Warren Washington Association for Mental Health (WWAMH) requests continued funding to support a PSH program in Hudson Falls, NY. This project supports a total of eighteen-unit apartment buildings providing permanent housing to homeless and chronically homeless adults with mental illness and/or co-occurring substance and alcohol abuse disorders. The project is staffed 24 hours a day and provides supportive services, case management, advocacy and linkages to treatment and community programs for residents. The project's goal is to improve residential stability and increase life skills abilities and self-determination.

### **Glens Falls Housing Authority**

#### **Glens Falls HA – Community**

Grant PIN: NY0715

**Project Description:** Glens Falls Housing Authority requests continued funding to support a PSH program in Warren and Washington Counties, NY. This tenant-based Shelter Plus Care program for chronically homeless persons with disabilities provides rental subsidies for chronically homeless individuals and families disabled by mental illness and/or chronic substance abuse. This program serves 5 households, and 19 individuals. These individuals access community services such as mental health treatment, substance abuse treatment, and employment assistance.

#### **Glens Falls HA - Housing First**

Grant PIN: NY0875

**Project Description:** Glens Falls Housing Authority requests continued funding to support a PSH program in Hudson Falls, NY. This tenant-based Shelter Plus Care program provides rental subsidies for 16 individuals disabled by mental illness and/or chronic substance abuse. These individuals access community services such as mental health treatment, substance abuse treatment, and employment assistance. The subsidies will assist clients in accessing scattered site apartments.
