

# Consortium HOME-ARP Stakeholder Survey Fact Sheet

#### Activities Recommended for Prioritization

Stakeholders prioritized **Affordable Rental Housing Development.** However, this activity barely surpassed the voting for Support Services, Acquisitions and Development of Non-Congregate Shelters, and Tenant Based Rental Assistance. This tells us, **there is a need for funding within all activities.** 



#### Percentage of Funding Recommended for Activities




In terms of funding allocation, a majority of stakeholders preferred to **allocate:** 

- 20% to Tenant Based Rental Assistance
- 20% to Support Services
- 20% to Acquisitions and Development of Non-Congregate Shelters
- 40% of fund allocation for Affordable Housing Development.

Stakeholders prioritized the need of qualifying populations within the Consortium as such:

- 1st Priority: Homeless
- 2nd Priority: Fleeing or Attempting to Flee Domestic Violence, Sexual Assault, Stalking, or Human Trafficking
- 3rd Priority: At-risk of homelessness
- 4th Priority: Other populations experiencing or at greatest risk of housing instability

#### **Participation Numbers:**

**263** *individuals from* **105** *organizations* were invited to participate.

**36** participants from **105** organizations responded.

# **Stakeholder Subpopulation Preference Choices:**

- Persons with Severe Mental Illness
- Victims/Survivors of Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault, Stalking, or Human Trafficking
- Persons exiting the criminal justice system
- Persons with Substance Use Disorder
- Households who have been chronically homeless
  (e.g., homeless multiple times within a short peri-

# Feedback:

Feedback from stakeholders included the need for housing that is actively affirming of the LGBTQ+ population, prioritizing youth for housing and mitigating racial disparities in all services. Additionally, due to the lack of funding streams that allow for flexibility, stakeholders did not want to specify any subpopulation for targeted preference.
